Subject: Road Grading, Paving, and Parking in Scotia Phase 3 Work Area

Dear Resident,

This letter is to provide you with 48-hour notice that there will be parking closures on all streets, in the phase 3 area, over the next 6 weeks.

Wahlund Construction, Inc. has started the roadway grading in the Town of Scotia Phase 3 project area. During this portion of work you will be asked to move your vehicles to alternative parking locations during the work hours of 7 am to 5 pm. On any given day, no parking signs will be set out on roads that need to be cleared of all parked cars.

The plan is to have no parking on Main St and B St on the same days, leaving 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>, available for parking. Then on days that 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> street will have no parking Main St. and B St. will be available to park. B St. Alley will also be closed to parking at different times during this process. At no time will all the streets and alleys be closed to parking. However, it will switch daily between the different areas.

Wahlund Construction crews will be putting out door hangers and no parking signs on a regular basis to keep you informed about which streets will be closed. The best rule of thumb will be if at night there is a no parking sign on the street then at 7 am the following morning crews will be out working on that street.
